The ultimate goal (impact) of the project is reduced poverty of marginalized and vulnerable river basin communities through increased access to and control over water resources.

The selected candidate will work in close collaboration of research and programme team of CUTS International and will be responsible for research and technical assistance in planning, implementation of various interventions under TROSA.
