A. ACCOUNTING POLOICIES

1. Accounting Concept

a. The Society follows cash system of accounting and recognizes grants/funds utilised in India as income in the year in which those are utilised, remaining debit/credit balances are taken as Assets/Liabilities in the name of Grants in Aid. Expenditure have been accounted for on cash basis.

Funds are remitted abroad for utilization from FCRA fund, these funds remitted abroad to project partner or for expenditure are debited to concerned funding agency/project account and such part of grant remitted above neither accounted for as Income nor Expenditure.

 Accounting policies not specifically referred to otherwise are consistent and in consonance with generally accepted accounting principles and accounting standards.

2. Fixed Asset

Fixed assets are accounted at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidentals related to acquisition. Fixed Assets has been physically verified by the management at the last date of accounting period, and no discrepancy was found.

On disposal of fixed assets original cost and accumulated depreciation on that disposed asset is reduced from Fixed assets & Depreciation Reserve. Profit/Loss on Sale of Asset is credited/debited to Profit/Loss on sale of assets and taken in Income & Expenditure a/c after allocation to project cost.

Purchase of fixed assets out of utilization of grant received for this purpose is credited to Capital reserve account by debiting Fixed Assets Account.

3. Inventories

The Society is not engaged in any trading or business activities so question of valuation of inventories does not arise, as there is no inventories held by the Society.

4. Depreciation

Depreciation has not been charged on the fixed assets during the year. Acquisition of Fixed Assets are claimed as Utilisation/Expenditure against income for the purpose of Income Tax during the current financial year.

5. Accounting of Funds sent abroad and in India for expenditure

Funds are transferred for utilization abroad and in India time to time. Funds remitted abroad from FCRA fund to project partner are debited to concerned funding agency/project account and not accounted for as an Income or expenditure.

Funds transferred to project partners in India are accounted for as expenditure incurred at the time of transfer of the fund on the basis of agreement with recipient party and vouchers for such utilization are not generally obtained.

6. Allocation of Expenditure

In case where expenditure are not specifically incurred for any project, Expenditure is debited to Expenditure head at the time of incurring Expenditure. Such expenditure is allocated by the management to the project at the time of finalization of accounts.

7. Branch Accounting

We have been explained that the society is maintaining branch\office at Chittorgarh, Delhi and Calcutta only. Accounts of these branches\offices have been consolidated with Head Office Accounts. There is no other branches /office/establishment or setup of consumer unity & trust society of any type in India & abroad except above.

8. Accounting of grants in case of continuing projects.

In the cases when society receives grants in advance for continuing project, the amount utilized during the financial year in India is shown as income and expenditure of that year in Income and Expenditure account and balance unutilized/over utilised is shown as current liability/current assets in the Balance Sheet.

B. NOTES ON ACCOUNTS (OTHERS)

- 1. Previous year's figures have been regrouped and rearranged on the basis of nature of activities of expenditure.
- 2. In view of nature of the activities being carried on by the Society, society is not dealing in any commodity hence there is no quantitative details.

- 5. Advances in Schedule 4 under Current Assets of Balance Sheet as on 31st March 2019 includes debit balance of Consumer Unity and Trust Society (General Books) amounting Rs.1,21,48,063.43.
- 6. Provisions of Provident Fund, ESI & Gratuity Act are applicable on the Society and the Society is regular in depositing the contributions towards the P.F. and ESI, no material discrepancies have been noticed during the period under review.
- 7. The Society has taken new Group Gratuity cash accumulation Policy from LIC of India and contributions are made on actuarial valuation basis. Society is making payment of premium of this policy which is charged against revenue.
- 8. Loans, Advances and deposits, Sundry Creditors and balance of grants receivable/payable are subject to confirmation and as certified by the management. As explained by Management the Current assets/ Loans and advances are stated at an amount, which is, in the opinion of the management, not in excess of their recoverable value.
- 9. Figures of Utilization of grants of each project (project-wise) & balances outstanding (Debit or Credit) are as certified by the Management.
